General Description

The School District of Philadelphia, through the Division of Career and Technical Education is looking for dynamic School District teachers and staff to run after-school media clubs in their schools. Each club will have a choice of a school newspaper (on or off line), radio broadcast, television production and/or podcast. Each program will have a Temple University mentor assigned to their students and a visiting journalist.

Days/Times

The after-school program will begin during the week of October 1, 2013, and will end in May 31, 2014. The clubs will meet 1 hour a week. Teachers will be paid the standard EC rate of \$38.92 per hour.

Expected Outcomes

- Students will be exposed to the field of journalism.
- Students reading, writing, and listening skills will increase.

Criteria for Selection

- Be a teacher or staff member within the school.
- Have an excellent attendance record, defined as no more than eighteen (18) occasions of absence for personal illness in the last three (3) years. A consecutive period of absence constitutes one occasion.
- Have no unsatisfactory documentation currently on file.
- Selection will be in accordance with Article XVII-Section C-1 of the PFT Contract.
